I am writing to update you about the status of the Monmouth Water Association's request for federal funding to upgrade its drinking water infrastructure. You may be pleased to know that, with my support, \$3,555,000 has been included for this request in the fiscal year 2025 Interior and Environment Appropriations bill recently approved by the Senate Appropriations Committee.

Although there are several more steps in the process before any appropriations bills are finalized and sent to the President for signature, including reconciling differences between the House of Representatives and Senate versions of the bills, I wanted you to know of this important development. As Vice Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, I will continue to advocate for investments that will improve Maine communities.
